Introduction

The Gaza Strip faces severe humanitarian and economic challenges due to the 17-year-long blockade imposed on it, resulting in difficult living conditions for its population. Limited access to basic necessities, including food, clean water, and shelter, has created a heavy reliance on international aid to meet essential needs. These urgent needs continue to grow as the Gaza Strip due the continuous aggression that causes significant damage to its infrastructure and healthcare services with each attack additionally Gaza Strip is considered the third most densely populated area in the world due to the large number of refugees residing there, which makes the needs of its population multi-faceted and highly urgent. The Humanitarian Intervention Plan is designed to address urgent needs and improve the region's humanitarian and economic conditions. Considering the demographic and humanitarian situation, the plan identifies and prioritizes actions that align with the need for effective and sustainable intervention across all sectors. It focuses on providing immediate aid, support, and promoting sustainable development through integrated collaboration among relevant stakeholders to achieve desired outcomes and meet the needs of the vulnerable population in the area of need.

These plans are developed in coordination and partnership with local and donor organizations and are implemented in a quickly and effective manner.

Additionally, we are committed to the long-term impact of our interventions.
