Gazze Destek Association works in accordance with Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2030



In this context, Gazze Destek Association extends its thanks and appreciations to all benefactors and donor institutions for supporting societies' needs,


We also wish to continue with our collaboration with donor institutions to implement the association's humanitarian intervention plans in the next three years.

Providing rent allowance for 6 months for residents of damaged houses or houses inadequate for habilitation and need a long time before applying for restoration works.


